In HIV differentiated service delivery models in the provision of prevention, treatment and care services for key populations in the Caribbean region for documentation as a promising practice

**Civil Society, NGOs, National Programmes and Academia are encouraged to submit** Differentiated service delivery: is a client-centered approach that simplifies and adapts HIV services to better serve the needs of key populations and reduce unnecessary burdens on the health system.

**Key Populations:** Persons living with HIV, Men who have Sex with Men, Sex Workers, Transgender persons, Youth, Mobile and Migrant populations.

## Promising practices criteria:

- Suggested effectiveness of an intervention in addressing a specific challenge or programmatic gap/focus in a country or organization's HIV response.
- The challenge or programmatic focus is important to other programmes across the Region.
- Successful application of the intervention in the organization and context.
- Positive results based on set objectives.
- Potential for replicability in other programmes and contexts.
