

FACTS ON HIV RESPONSE GUYANA

PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV

In 2017, there were **8200** People Living with HIV. An increase of **1600** from 2010.

NEW HIV INFECTIONS

There more than **500** new HIV infections recorded in 2017 across all ages.



AIDS-RELATED DEATHS

In 2017, there were more than **200** deaths as a result of AIDS.





29.4% of women and men aged 15–49 years reported discriminatory attitudes towards People Living with HIV in 2014.

KNOWLEDGE OF HIV

In 2014, **51.5%** of young women and **40%** of young men aged 15-24 years had knowledge of how to prevent HIV.



6 GAP TO REACHING SECOND 90

In 2017, there was an estimated **1417** People Living with HIV who **WERE NOT** on treatment.
